2010 Region 17 Select Stallion Service Auction and Futurity

Stallion Requirements

1. The Stallion Owner will donate one or more breedings to the Region 17 Select Stallion Service Auction. The Minimum Bid accepted by the Auction for each breeding will be 25% of the stud fee specified by the Stallion Owner.
2. The Stallion Owner will be given one (1) free entry into the Futurity for every breeding they donate to their stallion. This means the stallion owner can enter a foal into the futurity that must be the resulting offspring of the same stallion nominated to the auction and must result from the same breeding year the auction breeding was intended for. The Mare must also be nominated by December 31st 2011 for the resultant foal to be eligible for the futurity.
3. Stallion services not sold at the Auction will be available for purchase until December 31st, 2010.
4. If a stallion service has not sold by December 31st 2010, the Stallion Owner will not receive a free entry into the Futurity. If the Stallion Owner wishes to buy back the breeding for the Minimum Bid by January 15th 2011, the Stallion Owner will be able to enter 2 offspring in the Futurity.
5. If the stallion is sold or leased prior to the conclusion of the prescribed breeding season, the Stallion Owner will be responsible to the purchaser to insure that the breeding purchased through the Region 17 Select Stallion Service Auction will be honoured by the new owner or lessee.
6. In the event the Stallion Owner, by reason of death or injury of the stallion, is unable to fulfill this agreement, the breeding deposit will be refunded without interest, unless there is frozen semen available.

To nominate a stallion to the 2010 Region 17 Select Stallion Service Auction, the following is to be provided by the Stallion Owner by June 1, 2010:

1. A completed Stallion Nomination form, signed by the Stallion Owner
2. A photo of the stallion, may be high resolution jpeg file
3. A copy of breeding contract(s) for donated breedings
4. If available, a video to be used at Stallion Auction promotions.
